Entries in these classes are confined to registered horses ridden by members of British Showjumping in accordance with BS Rule 79. **If there is space in a Class, late entries MAY be taken on the day. These entries will jump first and there will be a £3 surcharge per entry.**

Class 701 Equitop Myoplast Senior Foxhunter First Round/1.20m Open

Rule 310. Two Phase. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.20m. DRAWN ORDER

First place rosette kindly sponsored by Equitop Myoplast. In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses may compete in one section only.

Foxhunter section: (a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 700 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 310.6. (b) For all registered horses born on or after 1 January 2011, irrespective of points. Horses will be eligible for double clear qualification to attend second rounds providing they reach the age of seven years or under in the same calendar year as the Foxhunter Final - in accordance with rule 310.6. Four double clears will qualify. Four Double clears will qualify for the Senior Foxhunter Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st June-31st May inclusive. Those horses that have qualified for the Senior Foxhunter Championship in 2017 are not eligible for qualification to the 2018 Championship.

Open section: For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money.

Qualifying riders will be taken from designated 1.30m Open (Table A10 or Table A7) classes.

To be eligible to qualify, riders must be aged 25 years or under as of 1st January 2018. For registered horses of any grade to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. NB – Riders eligible for qualification must declare at time of entry.

The two highest placed eligible horse/rider combinations will qualify, disregarding those already qualified, for the final at the RHS 2018. Qualifiers must jump clear in the first round. Entries will be limited in the final to a maximum of 2 horses per rider.

Rule 312. Table A7. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m. DRAWN ORDER

First place rosette kindly sponsored by Connolly's RED MILLS In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses may compete in one section only.

Newcomers: Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 375 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 312.6

(b) For all horses born on or after 1st January 2012, irrespective of Points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of six years or under in the same calendar year as the Newcomers Final - in accordance with Rule 312.6.

Qualifies for: Connolly's RED MILLS Senior Newcomers Second Round. Qualifying period 1st June - 31st May inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those horses which jump a clear round in the First Round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four Connolly's RED MILLS Senior Newcomers First Round competitions in any qualifying period, will qualify to compete in a Connolly's RED MILLS Senior Newcomers Second Round, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). To obtain a double clear qualification, even if the horse is the only clear round, it must jump a jump-off round and jump clear to gain a double clear round.

1.10m Open: For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year.

Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any senior International Team (Nations Cup, World, European Championships and Olympic Games are not eligible).

Pony riders, Children, Junior and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible (Excluding Veteran and Home Pony Teams).

Height of fences not to exceed 1.20m in first round. Must include a double and a treble combination and a water tray.

First TWO horse/rider combinations will qualify, disregarding those already qualified, for the final at the RHS 2018.

Qualifiers must jump clear in the first round. Entries will be limited in the final to a maximum of 2 horses per rider and to those riders not competing in any open class of 1.40m or above.
