### **Class 701 Equitop Myoplast Senior Foxhunter First Round/1.20m Open**

Rule 310. Two Phase. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.20m. DRAWN ORDER

First place rosette kindly sponsored by Equitop Myoplast. In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses may compete in one section only.

Foxhunter section: (a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 700 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 310.6

(b) For all registered horses born on or after 1 January 2012, irrespective of points. Horses will be eligible for double clear qualification to attend second rounds providing they reach the age of seven years or under in the same calendar year as the Foxhunter Final - in accordance with rule 310.6 Four double clears will qualify.

Four Double clears will qualify for the Senior Foxhunter Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st June-31st May inclusive. Those horses that have qualified for the Senior Foxhunter Championship in 2018 are not eligible for qualification to the 2019 Championship.

Open section: For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

The two highest placed eligible horse/rider combinations will qualify, disregarding those already qualified, for the final at the RHS 2019. Qualifiers must jump clear in the first round.

Newcomers: (a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 375 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 312.6 (b) For all horses born on or after 1st January 2013, irrespective of Points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of six years or under in the same calendar year as the Newcomers Final - in accordance with Rule 312.6.

Four double clears will qualify for the Senior Newcomers Second Rounds. Qualifying period 1st June - 31st May inclusive.

1.10m Open: For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any senior International Team (Nations Cup, World, European Championships and Olympic Games are not eligible). Pony riders, Children, Junior and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible (Excluding Veteran and Home Pony Teams).

First two horse/rider combinations will qualify, disregarding those already qualified, for the final at the RHS 2019.

Qualifiers must jump clear in the first round.

Entries will be limited in the final to a maximum of 2 Horses per rider and to those riders not competing in any open class of 1.40m or above.
