



## FIFE SHOW ENTRIES INFORMATION

**\*\*Please ensure you read before completing entry form\*\***

### GENERAL INFORMATION

**ENTRY FORMS** must be completed by a person 18yrs old or over and the person completing the form must be, or become, a Member of the Association.

**FULL PAYMENT** for entry **MUST** accompany forms, whether submitted by email, post or online. Please take note of the closing date(s) and ensure that entry forms and fees are lodged with the Secretary by that date. The fee you are due to pay will be dependent on the date your entry form **and fee** reaches the Secretary. Payment may be made by cheque or by Bacs. Telephone entries will **NOT** be taken as entry forms must be signed by exhibitor.

**POSTAL ENTRIES:** please DO NOT send coins in the post.

**PARAMEDIC FEE:** a compulsory fee of £2 per ring handler /rider/driver/entrant is payable to offset the cost of paramedic provision. Entrants in Classes with **no entry fee** (e.g. Young Handlers, Fancy Dress) do not need to pay a Paramedic fee.

**ONLINE ENTRY FACILITY:** please ensure you have included MEMBERSHIP (other than Showjumpers), the £2 COMPULSORY PARAMEDIC FEE per ring handler/rider/driver, and the compulsory £1 online admin fee before confirming your basket total. To complete your purchase, **please remember to click back to the website from Worldpay**, OR YOUR TRANSACTION MAY NOT BE CORRECTLY PROCESSED. You will receive an email detailing your online entries processed.

**RULES:** please make sure you have read and are familiar with the Fife Show Rules at the front of the Premium List or on the Entries page of the website. By **signing an Entry Form**, you are declaring that you have read, and agree to abide by, both the **Entries Information**, included herewith, as well as the **Fife Show Rules**.

**INSURANCE:** as an exhibitor/owner, you are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by you, your employees, support personnel, your agents or your animals. All exhibitors/owners, therefore, **must have valid third party liability insurance**.

**CLOSING DATES:** are detailed on individual forms. Entries for inclusion in the Catalogue must be submitted by Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> April. Thereafter, **Late Entries** (non-Catalogued) will be taken for cattle, sheep, heavy horse, light horse, poultry and home produce classes from 14<sup>th</sup> April – 10<sup>th</sup> May. **LIGHT HORSE SHOW DAY ENTRIES** will be taken on 18<sup>th</sup> May for classes 134-204 only. **PLEASE NOTE – OTHER THAN IN THE LIGHT HORSE SECTION, NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED ON SHOWDAY.**

**SUBSTITUTION OF ENTRIES:** if you have entered an animal that is subsequently unable to come forward, you may replace it with a substitute – only for the **same class as originally entered**. Details of substitutes **must** be advised to the Secretary by **noon on 17<sup>th</sup> May** at the latest.

**WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES:** if you need to withdraw entries, please see **Fife Show Rules** regarding refunds (except for Showjumping entries where BS Rules apply).

**MOVEMENT OF LIVESTOCK:** Cattle, Sheep, Horses & Poultry must be on the Show Ground before 8.00am and not be removed until after the Parade of Livestock has finished.

**ADMISSION WRISTBAND ALLOCATION:** is detailed on each entry form. PLEASE NOTE: children aged Under 14yrs are admitted free of charge – a wristband is not required. See below re wristbands for Home Produce & Poultry Exhibitors.

### CATTLE SPECIFIC INFORMATION

**BVD DECLARATION:** All exhibitors must complete and sign the **BVD Declaration Form** and send in with their entry form, or as soon as possible afterwards. Ear tag numbers **must** be included on the form. Cattle entered must be from **accredited or negative herds or have been individually tested as BVD negative if they come from a not negative herd**. If you intend entering a **PAIRS CLASS**, please **include this on your entry form**, even though no entry fee is payable.

**CATTLE PASSPORTS:** All calves born on or after 1 July 1999 must have a properly completed passport, which must be

available on request during the period of the Show. This is the responsibility of the keeper of the animal.

**Cattle Passports must be presented by the exhibitor at the Secretary's Tent before 11 am on Show day.**

**BULLS** of 1yr old or over must be ringed.

**BREEDING COWS** must be in calf or have had a calf within the 12 months prior to the Show.

Animals of any age that have had a calf must be shown as cows.

A miracle milker will be available to assist in milking dairy exhibits.

**CATTLE NUMBERS:** will be distributed by the section Steward. **Admission wristbands** will be posted out in advance of the Show.

### **SHEEP SPECIFIC INFORMATION**

**MV/CAE Accredited** sheep herd exhibitors must give an SAC valid Certificate of Status to the Steward on entry to the showfield BEFORE unloading any animals. These will be validated and returned to SAC.

This Show **WILL NOT** offer facilities suitable for Scrapie monitored flocks/herds.

**ADMISSION WRISTBANDS** will be posted out in advance of the Show.

### **HORSE SPECIFIC INFORMATION**

**HORSE PASSPORTS:** it is strongly advised these are carried at all times, as checks are possible.

**BROOD MARES:** must be four yrs. old or over. **Foals** must be at least 3 weeks old on Show day.

**HEAVY HORSE** competitors - please collect **numbers** from the Secretary's Tent at the Main Ring when you arrive at the Show. **Admission Wristbands** will be posted out in advance of the Show.

**LIGHT HORSE** competitors please collect badges, wristbands, numbers etc. from the Light Horse Convener's Tent in the Lorry Park when you arrive at the Show. **NOTHING WILL BE POSTED OUT TO YOU IN ADVANCE OF THE SHOW.**

**LIGHT HORSE SHOW DAY ENTRIES** will be taken on 18th May for classes 134-204 only - please take completed **Show Day Entry Form** (AND membership application form, if you are not already a current member), available on website, to the Light Horse Convener's Tent on Show day.

**HORSE AFFILIATIONS/QUALIFIERS:** BSHA (RIHS), BSPS, NPS Scotland, BHS, RoR, BDS, CHS, HPS, SPSBS, Equifest, TSR Championships, Blair Castle Series, Caledonian Showing Championships, Ingliston Elite Showing Championship Series, BRHHS Kilmannan Ridden Heavy Horse Championship, Osborne Refrigerators Private Driving Qualifiers, Victoria Food Company Open Private Driving Qualifier. See Notes at start of Horse Section in Schedule for further details of relevant information.

**\*\*PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT, IF ENTERING QUALIFIERS, YOU ARE AWARE OF, AND COMPLY WITH, EACH SOCIETY'S RULES & REQUIREMENTS\*\***

**BRITISH SHOWJUMPING** – schedule and entry open soon. Entries close 15 May 2019. **ALL** classes must be pre-entered, and entries will only be taken **ONLINE via [www.fifeshow.com](http://www.fifeshow.com)**. Queries to Sandra Low-Mitchell 07715 545769. Entry includes one admission wristband per rider. **Show entry wristbands** can be collected from the Showjumping caravan at the top of the Showfield.

### **HOME PRODUCE/POULTRY SPECIFIC INFORMATION**

**ENTRY FORMS for youngsters aged under 18yrs** must be completed by an adult aged 18yrs or over, who must be or become a Member of the Association (this can be Day Membership). **One entry wristband** will be given for each Home Produce/Poultry entry form/entrant. Please note if you are completing an entry form for a **young person aged 14-17yrs only**, you may need to purchase an **additional admission ticket**, as the young person will require the wristband to enter the Show and, if you are accompanying them, you will also need an admission ticket or wristband. Youngsters aged under 14yrs do not need a wristband .

Day Membership is only available to Home Produce/Poultry entrants or adults completing a Home Produce/Poultry entry form on behalf of an entrant aged under 18yrs. If you are completing a form for multiple children, you only need one Day membership for yourself. Please pay one paramedic fee per entry form.

**POULTRY ENTRANTS** MUST tick either the "Yes" or "No" box in relation to where birds are coming from and returning to. Birds must have been **in Scotland for a minimum of 13 days** before the date of the Show and have shown no signs of illness in that period.
