### **Fife Agricultural Association Equine Influenza Vaccination Requirements**

It will be mandatory that all horses, ponies & donkeys entering the Fife Show showground to be vaccinated against equine influenza.

The Equine must have completed, **at least**, the primary course of two vaccinations which are given not less than 21 days and not more than 60 days apart.

If sufficient time has elapsed, the Equine must also have received a (3<sup>rd</sup>) booster vaccination which is given not less than 120 days and not more than 180 days after the second component of the primary vaccination. Further booster vaccinations must be administered at intervals of not more than 365 days apart.

The last vaccination must have been administered at least 7 days **but no more than 365 days** before entering the Showground.

Foals under 6 months of age do not require vaccination.

All passports must be carried to the Show. All equines must be fit and well, currently showing no signs of illness, or having shown any signs of illness within the previous 10 days.

Random passport checks will be implemented and any equine without a valid vaccination protocol or owner/exhibitor unable to produce a valid passport will lead to immediate eviction of that equine from the showground.

Although we understand that individuals are obviously concerned for the health & safety of their own individual animals, the risk is no higher than at any other time. This policy will be under continual review.
